### Discounts

#### Full Week Discount

A discount of 5% is offered to all children that attend a full week of five full days and has been included in the table above.

#### Sibling Discount

A discount of 5% may be offered towards the child with the lower weekly fees if more than one child is attending. Terms and conditions apply.

### Minimum Booking

All our contracts are all year around. This works out to 51 weeks, as we are closed between Christmas and New Year's. A minimum booking of two full days is required to attend our Nursery.

There is no minimum booking for a child that is only accessing the Free Entitlement Government funded hours.

### Ad Hoc and Additional Hours

We are happy to provide ad hoc sessions for full and half days on top of regular bookings when we have the availability.

Early starts and late finishes will only be available when sufficient demand exists.

## Monthly Invoices

Invoices are sent out monthly and are to be paid in advance.

## Application Fee and Deposit

A non-refundable application fee of £50 is required with the return of an application form.

A deposit of £300 is required after we send out an offer letter. This will secure a space for your child with the agreed sessions. The deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable. However, it will be credited to your child's account and may be used towards your final invoice.

No application fee or deposit are required for children only accessing Free Entitlement Government funded hours.

## Funded Hours

We are pleased to be able to offer funded hours of care.

### Stretched Funding

Funded hours are available on a full year contract and the 15 weekly hours of funding for 38 weeks per year are stretched over the full year. This means all eligible parents/carers will be allocated 11 hours of funding per week for 51 weeks per year.

### Extended Hours

If parents/carers are eligible for the extended 15 hours of funding; these extra hours will also be stretched over the full year. This will mean 22 funded hours per week for 51 weeks per year.

### Consumables

The monthly fees shown on the previous page are all inclusive. We do not charge for any meals, consumables, or additional activities within these fees.

## Fully Funded Offer

We offer completely free 15 and 30 hour funded places. Places are offered on a stretched basis over the full year (51 weeks) and allocated based on availability within the nursery.

### 15 Hours Funding

- 570 hours per annum
- Monday to Friday (5 days)
- 3.46pm-6pm (2 hours 14 minutes per day)
- Total: 11.17 hours per week

### 30 Hours Funding

- 1,140 hours per annum
- Monday to Friday (5 days)
- 10am-2.28pm (4 hours 28 minutes per day)
- Total: 22.35 hours per week

### What does the fully funded session cover?

All funding is paid directly to the nursery by the local authority. According to the Department for Education funding guidance, the funding amount we receive covers the funded session but does not cover meals, other consumables, or additional activities.

Fully funded sessions do not include:

- All meals and snacks during the nursery day – breakfast, mid-morning snack, two-course cooked (on site) lunch, mid-afternoon snack, light tea and evening snack
- Formula milk
- Nappies and wipes
- Sun cream
- Calpol
- Extracurricular classes (sports, music and movement, etc.)
- Trips outside the nursery.

Water and cow's milk are provided by the nursery. Parents must provide food from home, however, due to allergies, some foods will not be permitted to be brought into the nursery.

### Consumables

Government funding is not intended to cover the costs of meals, consumables, additional hours or additional services. Early Years Providers can charge for consumables, meals and snacks, extra activities and additional hours provided they are not mandatory charges or a condition of accessing a place. Our optional per session charges are:

- Food = £3.75 (15 hours) | £7.50 (30 hours)
- Activities = £2.50 (15 hours) | £5 (30 hours)
- Non-food consumables = £1.57 (15 hours) | £3.15 (30 hours)
